

CONTESTS AND COMPETITIONS TO BE HELD IN OLD PUEBLO ARE REQUIRED TO PRE-REGISTER BY MARCH 12, 2010.

TABLE SETTING COMPETITION

This competition requires you to be pre-registered.

Entry form must be postmarked by March 12, 2010.

THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR ENTERING CONTESTS.

Decorate a beautiful table at the Pima County Fair. Show your talent at setting a beautiful table for everyone to see. Each participant will have one round table to decorate. The tables are 36" around and approx. 36" high. Each participant must provide all the items to decorate including the table coverings. **No live plants or flowers are allowed.**

1. Exhibitors are limited to setting one (1) round table for each entry. May be a place setting for two or four.
2. No pairs or groups.
3. A menu must be displayed with your setting.
4. Non perishable food or food models may be used for decorative purposes.
5. Theme for table must be original, decorative and functional.
6. Center pieces can not block the overall view of the table or interfere with the diner's view.
7. All table settings must stay until releasing time.

RECEIVING

Tables may be decorated on Saturday, April 10, 2010
10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

There will be three age groups.

- (1). 3 to 12
- (2). 13 to 17
- (3). Adult

Each participant must disclose which age group they are participating in. There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd place ribbon awarded in each age group.

ALL CONTESTS MUST HAVE PERSON'S NAME, ADDRESS AND PHONE NUMBER ON BACK OF CARD.

BEST SCRATCH PIE CONTEST

Bake your best pie and enter it in the Pima County Fair. Pie and crust must be made from scratch and have the recipe typed on a 3" X 5" card with name, address & phone number on the back. There will be two categories.

- (1). Cream pie
- (2). Regular pie

The Birdhouse is to be decorated by the person entering the contest and can use any media. The birdhouse must be able to stand alone on table for display.

Participant must have name, address & phone number on postcard when you arrive with birdhouse and not on the birdhouse. YOU MUST STATE ON ENTRY FORM IF IT IS MADE FROM SCRATCH OR IF IT IS A PRE-FAB BIRDHOUSE.

THE BIRDHOUSES WILL BE KEPT ON DISPLAY UNTIL THE END OF FAIR. THEY CAN BE PICKED UP AT RELEASING ON APRIL 25TH.

There will be two categories.

- (1) Birdhouse made from scratch (no kits)
- (2) Birdhouse pre-assembled and ready to decorate

The birdhouses will be graded on:

- (1). 50% on presentation
- (2). 40% on decoration
- (3). 10% on function for actual birdhouse

There will be three age groups.

- (1). 3 to 12
- (2). 13 to 17
- (3). Adult

Decorate an egg and enter it into the egg decorating contest. Use your imagination and make fancy, funny or artistic, etc. eggs. Use real eggs, wooden, plastic, paper, etc. to make your egg. You can decorate as many as three (3) eggs in your arrangement or only decorate one (1) egg. There are three categories:

- (1). Decorate a real egg

- (2). Real egg with nothing inside (blown)
- (3). Decorate any egg using any medium.

There will be three age groups.

- (1). 3 to 12
- (2). 13 to 17
- (3). Adult

Show off your talents and decorate an egg for the fair. The egg must be able to stand alone to be displayed on a table or shelf. **THE EGGS WILL BE KEPT ON DISPLAY UNTIL THE END OF FAIR OR IF THEY ARE REAL EGGS WE WILL KEEP THEM AS LONG AS ACCEPTABLE TO DISPLAY AND THEN WILL BE DISPOSED OF. ONLY FAKE EGGS WILL BE RETURNED. THEY CAN BE PICKED UP AT RELEASING ON APRIL 25TH.**
