All tickets are \$10.00 for the 11 days. **Exhibitor passes cannot be purchased if you do not have a paid entry in the fair. Entering contests does not qualify. If passes are not picked up, money will not be refunded.**

ALL FOOD ENTRIES WILL BE JUDGED ON SATURDAY, APRIL 10, 2010. FOOD ENTRY JUDGING WILL START AT 1:00 pm.

ALL FOOD ITEMS WILL BE DISPOSED OF AFTER FAIR.

Lots that have more than 15 entries will be judged as a class. WRAP or BAG ALL FOOD ITEMS to keep THEM FRESH for JUDGING. **Foods MUST BE made from "SCRATCH", NO PREPARED FOODS OR MIXES.**

The food items will have small stick on ribbons stuck on the entry tag but a regular ribbon will be awarded to the participant. This makes everything much easier to display and doesn't cover up another entry with the long ribbons.

Foods should be brought in at the temperature you would like them

to be judged. This can be done by

using insulated containers, wrapping carefully, and bringing your entry

as close to the judging time as your schedule will allow. **All food items must be in disposable dishes.**

Special recipes not requiring the jar to seal, must accompany the jar. Screw rim must be loosened but not removed. Do not remove paraffin. Canned goods must be free of stickiness and clearly labeled with the name of the product and the date made.
