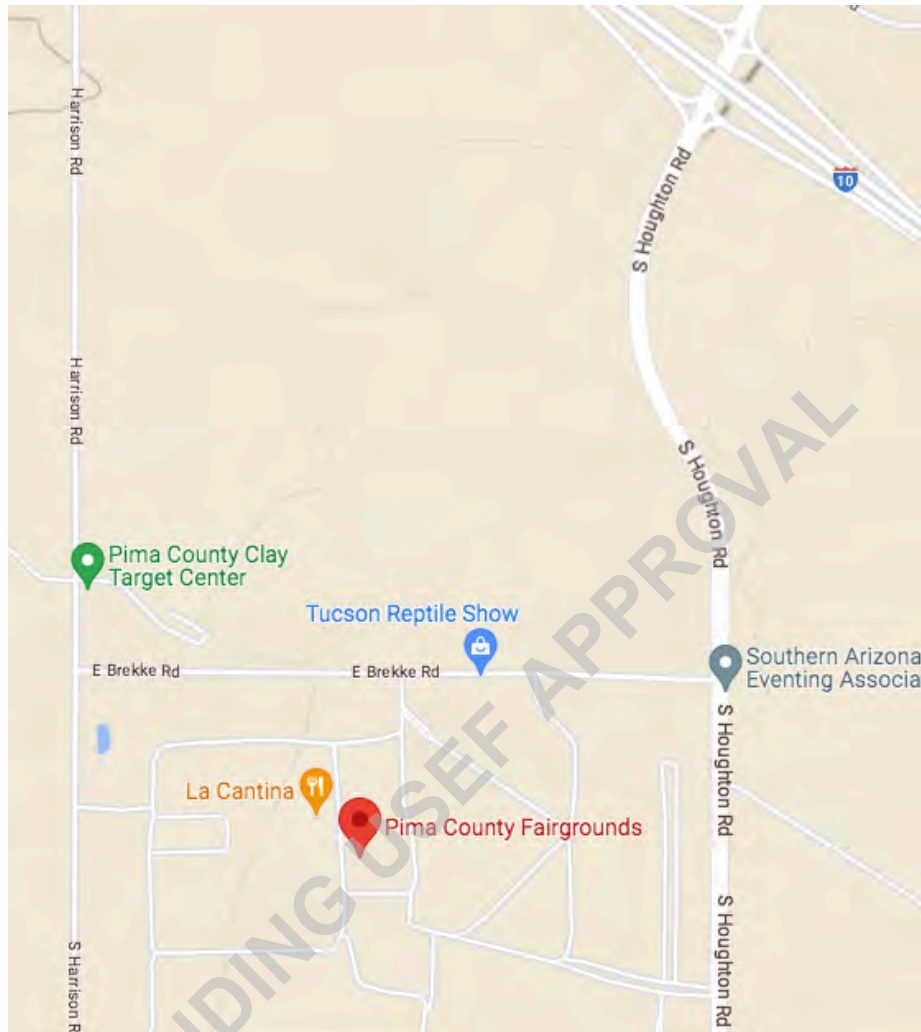

General Rules, Regulations, and Information

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

Senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Safe Sport Statement

All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org. Beginning December 1, 2018 all senior members of USEF will be required to complete a Safe Sport training class at USEF.org before competing in a USEF licensed competition. An exhibitor will not be allowed to compete until this requirement is met.

Health Requirements

All horses entering the state of Arizona must have a current health certificate. HORSES ENTERING FROM VS POSITIVE COUNTIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A HEALTH CERTIFICATE SIGNED WITHIN 14 DAYS OF SHOW ENTRY AND CONTAINING THE FOLLOWING VS STATEMENT: "I have examined the animal(s) represented on this certificate of veterinary inspection and have found no clinical signs of vesicular stomatitis and they have not originated from a premises under quarantine for vesicular stomatitis." Vaccination Requirements (per the USEF GR-845 Equine Vaccination Rule [CHAPTER 8F Welfare of the Horse] Rule Changes Effective 12/1/15).

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management.

Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Medical Waste

Sharps must be disposed of in containers provided in the barn areas or exhibitors will be subject to sanction.

Safety

Accidents involving competitors GR1317. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

General Rules, Regulations, and Information – Continued

Motorized Vehicles/Golf Carts

USEF Rule GR 1301. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside, will NOT be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s) or guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of these individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance equipment for people with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

RVs and Motor Homes

Arrangements must be made through the Horse Show and entry blank! Spaces are limited and are reserved on a first-paid basis only. To reserve a space, you must include the **weekly fee of \$200** along with your entry. These fees are related to enrolling and accommodating the special needs of Horse Show exhibitors and are in the optimum locations to the barns and rings. Any outside reservation whether accidentally or intentionally made by or through any other means will be subject to the following: Immediate removal to an exterior space in the 4-H lot (not convenient to the Horse Show or other services) additional nights' charges will be incurred for a check out later than noon, and/or an extra fee may be charged for equipment and golf cart parking, trailer parking, etc.

Parking

The parking of vehicles and horse trailers is not permitted in the barn areas. Upon your arrival, please follow parking signs and/or directions from members of the horse show staff.

Arrival and Departure

Arrival after 10 am on Monday/Departure by 10 am on each following Monday. Early arrivals and late departures **MUST BE ARRANGED IN ADVANCE**. Contact show manager, Jen Baltrus at 919.606.3222

Day Haulers

Allowed with prior permission from show management. There will be a day hauler fee of \$50/horse/day with a maximum charge of \$150 per show.

Stabling and Paddocks

Whether occupied by horses, feed, or tack, stalls will be available for \$375/week without bedding. Stalls are permanent or temporary 10'x10'-12'x12' with doors and dirt floors. All horses will have either a stall fee or a day hauler fee. Paddocks are limited, available on a first come first serve basis, and are priced according to size: \$200 small/week and \$300 large/week. Please contact show manager, Jen Baltrus at 919.606.3222, if you are interested in a weekly paddock rental.

Feed and Shavings

Hay and shavings only are available through the horse show office. Orders must be placed in the horse show office by 12:00 noon for same day delivery. For deliveries prior to arrival, please contact show manager, Jen Baltrus at 919.606.3222. Shavings are \$12/bag. An on-site feed vendor will be available to order/purchase grain and supplements.

Dogs

USEF GR1301.6. Dogs are not permitted to be loose on the competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behavior. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under chapters 6 and 7.

Holy Cow Tack and Feed will be on site November 2, 3, 4.





WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

EQUINE ACTIVITY LIABILITY ACT WARNING:

CAUTION: HORSEBACK RIDING AND EQUINE ACTIVITIES CAN BE DANGEROUS. RIDE AT YOUR OWN RISK.

Under the laws of most States, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for any injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY, HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNITY: In conjunction with my participation in any USEF Event, I hereby release, waive and covenant not to sue, and further agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless the following parties: USEF, USEF Recognized Affiliate Associations, the United States Olympic & Paralympic Committee (USOPC), USEF clubs, members, Event participants (including athletes/riders, coaches, trainers, judges/officials, and other personnel), the Event owner, licensee, and competition managers; the promoters, sponsors, or advertisers of any USEF Event; any charity or other beneficiary which may benefit from the USEF Event; the owners, managers, or lessors of any facilities or premises where a USEF Event may be held; and all directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors, and volunteers of any of the aforementioned parties (**Individually and Collectively, the "Released Parties" or "Event Organizers"**), with respect to any liability, claim(s), demand(s), cause(s) of action, damage(s), loss, or expense (including court costs and reasonable attorney fees) of any kind or nature ("**Liability**") which may arise out of, result from, or relate in any way to my participation in the USEF Events, including claims for Liability caused in whole or in part by the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties.

E. COMPLETE AGREEMENT AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: This Agreement represents the complete understanding between the parties regarding these issues and no oral representations, statements or inducements have been made apart from this Agreement. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be unlawful, void, or for any reason unenforceable, then that provision shall be deemed severable from this Agreement and shall not affect the validity and enforceability of any remaining provisions.

I HAVE CAREFULLY READ THIS DOCUMENT IN ITS ENTIRETY, UNDERSTAND ALL OF ITS TERMS AND CONDITIONS, AND KNOW IT CONTAINS AN ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND WAIVER FROM LIABILITY, AS WELL AS A HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS.

By signing below, I (as the participant or as the Parent/Legal Guardian of the minor identified below) hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of this Agreement in connection with my (or the minor's) participation in any USEF Event. If, despite this Agreement, I, or anyone on my behalf or the minor's behalf, makes a claim for Liability against any of the Released Parties, I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless each of the Released Parties from any such Liabilities as the result of such claim.

The parties agree that this agreement may be electronically signed. The parties agree that the electronic signatures appearing on this agreement are the same as handwritten signatures for the purposes of validity, enforceability, and admissibility.

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of _____ (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4.

BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. Horse Registration/Obtaining Numbers

See USEF RULES GR 1101, 1102. All horses competing in Federation non breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, and jumper and hunter seat equitation classes must be properly identified and must obtain a registration number from the USHJA. Applications for registration numbers can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the horse registration application form. Horses must still be recorded with USEF (either lifetime or annual) to receive national or zone points. See USEF Rules EQ 100.2, HU 101.1, and JP 100.2

All participants (riders, drivers, handlers, owner, trainers, coaches, agents or lessees) must present to the competition secretary a current USEF/USHJA membership card or copy thereof, or he/she will be assessed a \$45 USEF show pass fee and a \$30 USHJA show pass fee.

Microchipping

Beginning in the 2018 competition year, all horses competing in USEF licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter/jumping seat equitation classes not restricted to breed will be required to be microchipped to receive points. The following year, this will be a requirement for all horses competing in these classes. USEF has provided education material to competitors to learn more about microchipping and the rules.

Measurement

All small, junior and pony hunters must possess and present to the horse show office a current USEF measurement card. Measurements will occur on site Wednesday morning and Saturday morning at 8 am or by appointment through the horse show office.

Amateur Exhibitors

All amateur-owners and adult amateurs must present their amateur cards at the time of number pick up.

Entry Procedures

Entries can be made online at horseshowsonline.com or mailed to show manager, Jen Baltrus. If mailing, send completed entry blank along with a check for \$75 office fee and \$375 stall fee. These fees are nonrefundable after entries close. Stall reservations will not be held without prior payment.

Entry Closing Date

October 18, 2023. Entries must be postmarked by this date to be considered not late.

Late Entries

There will be a fee of \$65 for all entries received or postmarked after the closing date.

Refunds

All fees are refundable prior to closing date of show. After closing date, prior to arrival on grounds, all fees paid toward any classes or nomination fees are refundable with a veterinarian note or doctor note as applicable stating that horse or rider are unable to perform. Stall and office fees are nonrefundable after closing date.

Returned Checks

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be charged a \$50 NSF fee. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent or they will be turned into the USEF for further disciplinary action.

Canadian Exhibitors

The legend "US Funds" must be printed on the face of any Canadian check drawn on a Canadian bank and used to pay any fees for these shows. Entries received that do not adhere to this policy will be returned. No exceptions.

Minor Exhibitors

No minor's entry will be accepted unless it is properly signed by a parent or legal guardian.

Office/Facility/Medic Fee

Every horse entered will be charged a \$75 office fee.

Nonshowing Horses

Nonshowing horses must pay a stall fee or haul in fee, a \$75 office/facility fee and a \$75 nonshowing horse fee.

Trainer Splits

Trainer splits for tack stalls, feed, bedding, etc. will be accepted until noon on Friday of each week NO EXCEPTIONS. Any splits uncollected from the client will revert back to the trainer's account for payment. ALL TRAINERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO LEAVE AN OPEN CHECK OR PHOTO COPY OF CREDIT CARD IN THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE UPON CHECK IN.

Section Entry Fees

All classes must be declared by 5 pm on the day before the class is to be held. See below for specifics on add/scratches for 'A' rated divisions.

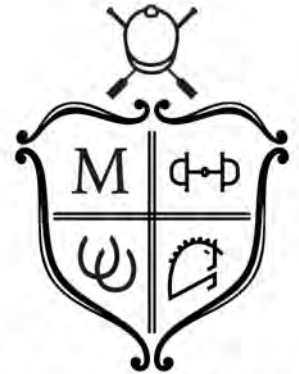
Combining and Splitting

(HU159 and HU166): In all 'A' rated hunter sections – Should entries warrant, all 'A' rated hunter sections will be split or combined following USEF rules and will be done at the close of the horse show office on the day preceding the first class in each section. Any post entries (adds) accepted after this time will not be considered in respect to the splitting/combining numbers. Same day scratches and 'no-shows' in all 'A' rated sections will forfeit their entry fee unless a vet scratch issued by the Official Show Veterinarian is received by the show secretary prior to the start of the section. When splitting all hunter classes, the preferred method will be "California Split" per HU162.

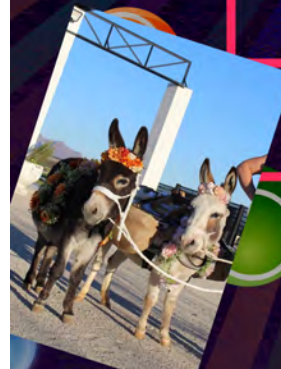

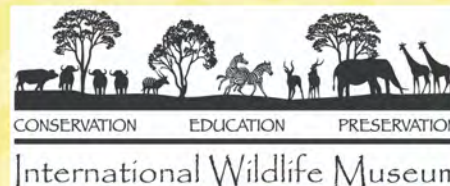
