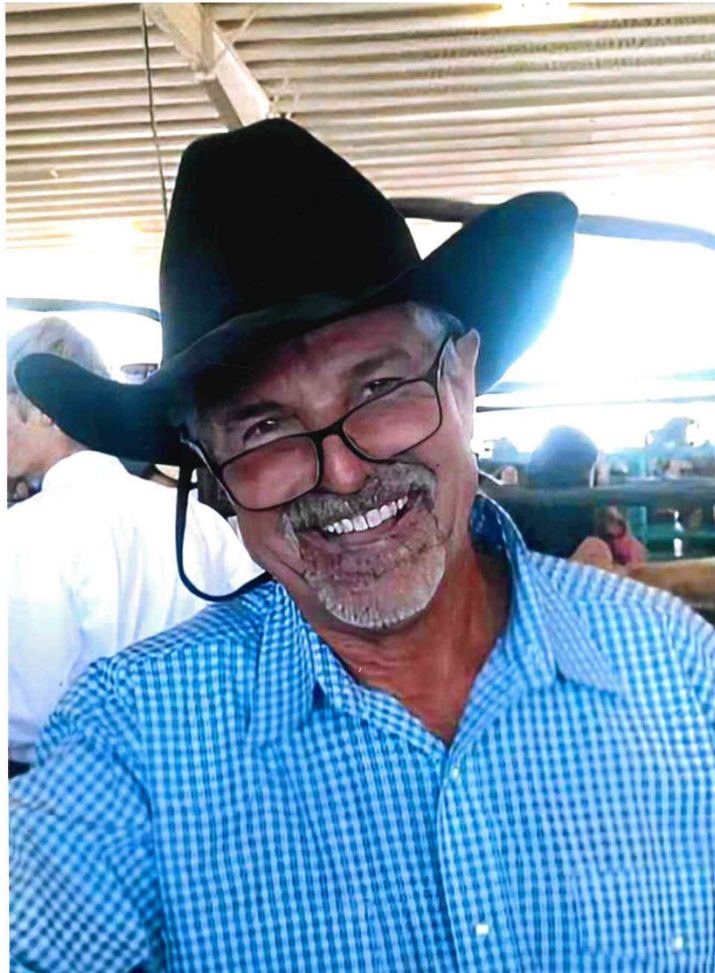


2024 Pima County Fair Hall of Fame

In recognition of countless hours of service and selfless dedication, the following individual has been recognized as a recipient of the Pima County Fair Hall of Fame Award.



JAMIE JAMESON

A Tucson native, Jamie has had a longtime association with the Pima County Fair. Not old enough to be in 4-H, he helped family members and friends with their pigs and chickens at the Fair when it was still at the Rodeo grounds. His first year in 4-H was in 1972, the first year the Fair was at the Houghton Road location. He was in the Tanque Verde Community 4-H Club sheep and dog projects and then joined the Tanque Verde Livestock Club. When his kids were in the Tanque Verde Valley Club, he was the swine leader for 8 years. He served as both the County Swine Project Director and Barn Superintendent. For years, Jamie has had a key role in setting up the swine pens prior to the Fair and lining up the pigs for the shows and auctions. After working 16 years as a diesel mechanic for Tanque Verde Equipment Contractors, in 2001 he started Jamie's Mobile Truck and Equipment Repair, which he owns and operates. Jamie has also been a Tucson Rodeo volunteer since 1977.
