Cow-Themed Cupcakes: Decorate cupcakes with cow patterns using fondant or icing. You can even make mini cow figurines as toppers.

Goat Cheese Stuffed Peppers: Prepare colorful bell peppers stuffed with a mixture of goat cheese, herbs, and spices for a tasty appetizer.

Judges will only award ribbons to entries that meet the high standards of the competition. Each entry will be evaluated on its own merit using the Danish System, and all judging decisions are final. If your entry does not receive an award, it does not reflect on its edibility but rather the strict criteria set by the judges.

Only the Best of Class, Best of Show, and People's Choice awards will be judged in direct competition with other entries. Divisions with more than 15 entries will be judged as a separate class, while those with fewer than 10 entries will be combined with another class for Best of Class awards. Attention to detail is crucial in this competition. It is the responsibility of the Artist to collect any award vouchers from the Home Arts reception desk and cash them at the Fair Office Cashier Window as soon as they are issued.

GENERAL RULES

- No business cards are allowed on any entries.
- Entries must be from an individual cook.
- Exhibitors are responsible for determining which class and division they wish to compete in. Improperly classified entries could be disqualified with no entry fee refund given.
- Judging is closed to the public and all judging decisions are final.
- All food entries will be disposed of after the Fair, so please use disposable plates.
- Wrap or bag all food entries to keep them fresh for the judges. All foods must be made from scratch.
- Submit four (4) candies, cupcakes, muffins, cookies, fudges, biscuits, or rolls per plate or Ziploc bag.
- Jars must be standard KERR or MASON canning jars only and sealed.
- All canned jars must be sealed upon arrival. If not sealed due to health hazards, canned jars will only be judged on appearance and texture. Only 16 oz., pint, 32 oz., or quart jars are allowed.
- The Fair reserves the right to remove and dispose of any foods showing signs of spoilage. A picture may be taken in place of the food entry if it spoils during the Fair. Only 10 entries are allowed for all classes.
- If your entry is late, it may not be judged.
