The Pima County Fairgrounds and Ray Cammack Shows are pleased to invite you to a Special Needs Day Party, Tuesday, 4/21/2026. The Special Needs Day Party is completely free, and gates open at 9:30 a.m.

Specially scheduled performances will begin at 10:00 a.m. The carnival rides located in **Kiddie Land and the main carousel** will also open at 10:00 a.m. and will remain open until noon. Most commercial vendors and food vendors **will not be open** during the event so please plan to bring sack lunches for your group. Beverage stations and bathrooms will be available during the event.

We remind attendees, program coordinators, teachers, chaperones and attendants that the Special Needs Day Party is a private event, that takes place on the Fairgrounds, when the Pima County Fair is not open for business. Therefore, the main carnival midway and games, food vendors and exhibitors will NOT be open until 3:00 p.m., after the Special Needs Day event has ended. Attendees of Special Needs Day are welcome to remain on the grounds after the Special Needs Day event has ended or get a hand stamp to return later after the fair and vendors have opened.

As always, the Special Needs Day Party has limited space for attendees. This program is intended as a group activity for school and social service programs serving the disabled and is not intended as a family function. Due to limitations, single participant registration is limited to the individual and one attendant.

Pre-registration is required and available on a first come first served basis. Pre-registration does not guarantee confirmation to participate in the program. Qualifying registrants will receive a letter of confirmation, which must be presented for entry.
