ENTRIES

1. ENTRY FEE is \$10.00 per head
2. Exhibitor age: participant must be 9 years of age by January 1, 2026.
3. If there are less than four (4) Exhibitors in a breed class they may be entered in "ALL OTHER BREED CLASS"

EXHIBITOR PASSES/PARKING

Exhibitor passes MUST be paid with a separate check (payable to **Southwestern Fair Commission**) and sent in with your entries **BY APRIL 17, 2026**. Every person needing to exit and re-enter the fairgrounds must have an exhibitor pass. Adults **\$25.00**, children 6-12, **\$10.00**, under six no charge. Each exhibitor will receive one parking pass. Extra parking passes: **\$20.00** each, limit of 2. Additional parking passes should be indicated on the entry form and paid for along with your exhibitor passes. Passes are good for all 11 days of the fair.

CHECK IN

Check-in will begin on Friday, April 17, 2026, by 5:00 p.m. Animals showing signs of illness will not be accepted.

JUDGING

Judging will begin on Friday, April 17, 2026, starting at 7:00 p.m.

RELEASE

Animals will be released after the show and must be gone by Friday evening.

RULES/GUIDELINES

1. Weigh-in will be at time of unloading. There will be NO reweighing. Animals will be classified at this time; classifier's decision is final.
2. Minimum weight 75 lbs.
3. Must have ear notches, ear-tags, or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
4. Exhibitors are required to keep pens clean and clean pens before leaving.
5. All market Arizona Swine must be accompanied by a Certificate of Inspection of Exhibition Swine issues by an Arizona department of Agriculture at 1-800-294-0305. All breeding, prospect or feeder pigs must be accompanied by Seasonal Self- Inspection pass available through the Department of Agriculture.
6. All Exhibitors need credentials to enter.

ALL SWINE MUST HAVE THREE MEANS OF IDENTIFICATION.

7. Ear notching that conforms to the universal swine-ear notch system.
8. Premise identification numbers either through an ear-tag or tattoo.

9. All swine must have a Certificate of Show Swine
10. Negative Pseudorabies test are only required of Imported Pigs from Stage (4) States.
11. All Arizona Native Swine and State (5) States Swine are not required to test.
12. All swine must have a Certificate of Show Swine (Hauling Papers) from the Arizona Department of
13. Agriculture/State Veterinarians Office. You must call the Livestock Brand Inspector to issue you hauling papers before coming to any of the Pima County Ear Tagging.

SWINE SHOW

CLASSIFICATION GUIDELINES FOR BREED DIVISIONS

DUROC: RED IN COLOR

1. Must be red in color and possess Duroc Breed Characteristics.
2. Ears must be down and medium size.
3. Must have ear notches, ear-tags, or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
4. Must NOT have any white hair located on animal.
5. Must NOT have more than three (3) black spots on the skin and none of these spots can be larger than two inches in diameter.
6. Must NOT have any shading or indication of belt.

INELIGIBLE

1. White feet or white hair located directly above the feet of the animal.
(Commonly referred to as white socks.)
2. White spots or white hair located anywhere else on the animal's body not mentioned in the above wording.
3. Black spots larger than two inches in diameter located anywhere on the body.
4. Excessive dark or black pigment located anywhere on the body. Larger- dark colored patches of skin or obvious markings of a belt on the forefront of the animal.

HAMPSHIRE

Black in color with a white belt over forefront of the animal's body. Only if registration papers are provided a solid black or misbelted Hampshire will be accepted in this class.

1. Must possess Hampshire Breed Characteristics.
2. Ear must be erect.
3. Must have ear notches, ear-tags or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
4. Must NOT have any white hair or indications of streaking on the forehead.
5. Must not have any red hair.

INELIGIBLE

1. Any color hair other than black or white (red, sandy, etc.)

LANDRANCE: WHITE IN COLOR

1. Must possess Landrace Breed Characteristics.
2. Must have ear notches, ear-tags, or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
3. Must NOT have any color hair other than white.
4. Must NOT have more than three spots of skin pigmentation.
5. Must NOT have any spot of pigmentation larger than one U.S. minted quarter.
6. Ears must be down.

7. Any signs of weighted ear-tags or evidence of past existence, of such ear-tags are determined to be not permissible and are grounds for classification to crossbred class.

INELIGIBLE

1. Animal with non-white hair (red, black, sandy, etc.)
2. Animal with non-white skin pigmentation larger than one US minted quarter. (One spot or combination of spots).

YORKSHIRE: WHITE IN COLOR

1. Must be white in color and possess Yorkshire Breed Characteristics.
2. Must have ear notches, ear-tags, or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
3. Must NOT have any colored hair other than white.
4. Must NOT have colored skin pigmentation larger than one US minted silver dollar.
5. Must NOT have masking above the eye larger than a silver dollar.

INELIGIBLE

1. Any hair other than white located on any part of the body.
2. Any non-white pigmentation larger than a quarter or several small areas of pigmentation (masking around the forehead, total color spots cannot be larger than a silver dollar)

BERKSHIRE

The general color shall be black with white points, appearing on the nose, feet, and tail (any of these may be missing or an occasional splash of white may appear on the body).

1. Black and white animals with erect ears, exhibiting Berkshire Characteristics.
2. A Berkshire must have white on all four legs, face, and tail (unless tail is docked).
3. Must have ear notches, ear-tags or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
4. A Berkshire must NOT have a solid white or a solid black face from the ears forward.
5. A Berkshire must NOT have a solid black nose (rim of nose).
6. White is allowed on the ears, but NO solid white may appear on the ears.
7. One occasional splash of white may appear only on the lower one-half of the body.

INELIGIBLE

1. Any color present on the animal other than white or black.
2. Rounded and heavily drooped ears.

Formation of a belt encompassing one-third of the front part of the body.

CHESTER WHITE: WHITE IN COLOR

1. Must possess Chester White Breed Characteristics.
2. Must have ear notches, ear-tags or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
3. Must be solid white in color, no color on the skin larger than a silver dollar, no colored hair.
4. Ears must be down and medium size.
5. Any signs of weighted ear-tags or evidence of past existence of such ear-tags are determined to be not permissible and are grounds for classification to a crossbred class.

INELIGIBLE

1. Animal with non-white hair (red, black, sandy, etc.)

2. Animal with non-white skin pigmentation larger than a silver dollar. (One spot or combination of spots).

POLAND CHINA

Traditionally black with six white points (face, feet, switch of tail and down ears) splashes of white hair on the body are permitted.

1. Must possess Poland China Breed Characteristics.
2. Must have ear notches, ear-tags, or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
3. Must be black with six white points (face, feet and tail) with an occasional splash of white on the body.
4. A hog may not possess more than one black leg and be determined as Poland China.
5. Tail docking is permissible eliminating that white point.
6. Must have ears down.
7. Must NOT have evidence of belt formation.
8. Hogs that have weighted ear-tags or evidence of tampering with possible ear-tags will be classified into crossbred class.

INELIGIBLE

1. Lack of breed characters (erect ears, belt formation, etc.)
2. Red or Sandy hair and /or pigment.

SPOT: BLACK AND WHITE IN COLOR

1. Must possess Spotted Breed Characteristics.
2. Must have ear notches, ear-tags or tattoos with premise numbers in their ears.
3. Ears must be down and reasonable size.
4. Any red tinted or sandy brown spots are ineligible.
5. No solid black head from ears forward.
6. No distinct white belt pattern (hair or skin) encircling and extending down and onto each shoulder.

INELIGIBLE

1. Must not have any brown or sandy coloration on the body.
2. Solid black from ears forward.
3. Must not have a combination of black leg and black foot.
4. Very erect ears.
5. Complete belt information around the front one-third of the body reaching over the upper portion of the shoulders.

ALL CROSSBREDS AND A0B

6. All hogs that cannot fit the classifications of Breed division entries.
7. Must have ear notch, ear-tag or tattoos with Premises number in their ear.
