

SOUTHLINE TRANSMISSION PROJECT

While the CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route was subjected to a rigorous, multi-year federal environmental permitting process along with the rest of the Southline project, which required an environmental impact statement (EIS) that gained final approval through Records of Decision issued by the Bureau of Land Management and WAPA in 2016, it was not included in Southline's CEC 173 from the Arizona Corporation Commission.

Southline plans to submit its application to amend the CEC in November 2025.

Where is the CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route?

Please see the enclosed map. Specifically, the CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route follows the existing WAPA line (because it is in the WAPA right-of-way), starting at the Apache Substation and power plant, located approximately 25 miles east of the City of Benson in Cochise County, Arizona. From the Apache Substation, the Route extends 0.2 miles south and then 11 miles southwest. It then continues approximately eight miles in a general western direction, remaining north of Interstate 10. From there, the Route extends approximately 14 miles southwest, crossing to the south side of Interstate 10. The Route then proceeds approximately 22 miles in a general western direction until it is approximately two miles south of the existing TEP Vail Substation. The Route ends at the existing TEP Vail Substation.

Who will review Southline's application?

The CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route will be reviewed first by the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee and then by the Arizona Corporation Commission.

What is Southline Transmission Project?

Southline Transmission Project is a planned 280-mile, double-circuit, high-voltage transmission line that will ultimately connect the electrical transmission systems of the El Paso and Tucson areas. In Arizona, the project includes the upgrade of 57 miles of aged wooden transmission structures in Pima and Cochise Counties between Vail and Willcox. Additionally, Southline will construct 72 miles of new greenfield transmission in Cochise County between the Apache Generating Station and the Arizona/New Mexico border.

Why am I receiving this letter?

Southline will upgrade an existing transmission line between Willcox and Vail, Arizona. Southline plans to request an amendment to its Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (CEC 173) related to the upgrade and is hosting three open houses to answer questions about the proposed amendment. You have received this letter because you are listed as a property owner within one mile of the planned route.

Why is Southline applying to amend its Certificate of Environmental Compatibility?

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



Figure 1. CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route.

Southline plans to submit an application to amend CEC 173 issued by the Arizona Corporation Commission in 2017 (Decision No. 75978) and further amended in 2021 by Tucson Electric Power (TEP) for its Vail to Tortolita Route (Decision No. 77980). The planned amendment addresses the upgrade and replacement of 57 miles of Western Area Power Administration's (WAPA) aging 115kV transmission line with double-circuit 230/345 kV transmission, all within WAPA's existing right-of-way between Arizona Electric Power Cooperative's Apache Substation near Willcox, Arizona and TEP's Vail Substation near Vail, Arizona (CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route; Figure 1 enclosed).

Southline's amendment request will ask the Arizona Corporation Commission to add the CEC Apache to Vail Upgrade Route to Southline's current CEC to allow Southline to jointly own, construct, and operate infrastructure within the Upgrade Route, similar to the 2021 amendment for TEP's Vail to Tortolita Route (Decision No 77980).
