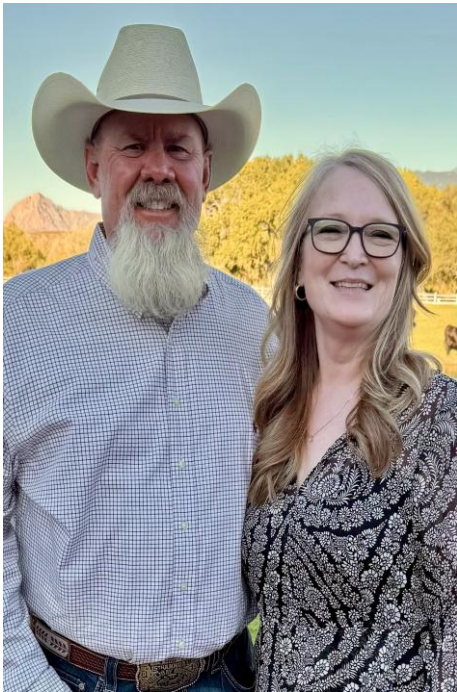


2026 Pima County Fair Hall of Fame
